Day 1 Singapore → Lisbon (Meals on Board)
Assemble at Changi International Airport. Have a pleasant flight to Lisbon check in hotel upon arrival.

Day 2 Lisbon (Dinner)

- Rossio Square - Pedro IV Square, has been one of the main squares in Lisbon
- Sao Jorge Castle - A Moorish castle occupying a commanding hilltop overlooking the historic centre of the Portuguese city of Lisbon
- Monuments of Discoveries - Built in honor of Henry the Navigator, instrumental in the success of the Portuguese explorations
- Belem Tower - Constructed to guard Lisbon from seafaring raiders.
- Jeronimo's Monastery - Grand religious building was historically associated with the early sailors as explorers, Vasco da Gama spent his last night before his voyage to the Far East

Day 3 Lisbon – Fatima – Porto (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Shrine of Fatima – Visit the miraculous appearance of the Virgin Mary to three children in 1917
- Gothic Church of St. Francis - View this most prominent Gothic monument in Porto.
- Porto Se Cathedral - It is one of Porto's oldest and most important local Romanesque monuments.
- Avenida dos Aliados - A sloping boulevard lined with grand buildings and a central promenade in the heart of the city.
- Clerigos Tower - View the foremost undisputed landmark of Porto and a reference to the city's histories.

Day 4 Porto – Salamanca (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Salamanca Orientation Tour - Known for its ornate sandstone architecture and for the Universidad de Salamanca

Day 5 Salamanca – Segovia – Madrid (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Roman Aqueduct - 2000 years-old, one of the best-preserved elevated Roman aqueducts
- Enjoy famous roast ' Suckling Pig' for lunch
- Puerta del Sol - The gate was probably called after a sun drawn on it, hence the name 'Sun Gate'
- Cibeles Fountain - Created in 1782, an emblematic and particularly beautiful fountain

Day 6 Madrid (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Toledo Cathedral – Visit one of the greatest Gothic and also the second largest cathedral in Spain.
- Tagus River - The most far-reaching river of the Iberian Peninsula.
- El Corte Ingles – Is the biggest department store group in Europe and ranks fourth worldwide'

Day 7 Madrid – Zaragoza – Barcelona (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Cathedral of El Pilar – Visit this Roman Catholic church in Zaragoza, It is reputed to be the first church dedicated to Mary in history.



Day 8 Barcelona (Breakfast)

- Montjuic Hill - A prominent hill overlooking the Barcelona harbour
- Eixample District – A district most diverse in terms of shopping, restaurants and nightlife
- Sagrada Familia Church – Visit Famous unfinished Roman Catholic church in Barcelona
- Las Ramblas - One of the best-known tourist hotspots in Barcelona
- Plaza Catalonia - A large plaza surrounded by monumental buildings, is Barcelona's busiest square
- La Roca Village – Designer outlet over 130 fashion boutiques offers a luxury experience at great prices
