Day 3 Madrid – Toledo – Madrid (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Toledo Cathedral – Visit one of the greatest Gothic and also the second largest cathedral in Spain
- Tagus River - The most far-reaching river of the Iberian Peninsula
- El Corte Ingles – Is the biggest department store group in Europe and ranks fourth worldwide.

Day 4 Madrid – Segovia – Salamanca (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Roman Aqueduct - 2000 years-old, one of the best-preserved elevated Roman aqueducts
- Enjoy famous roast 'Suckling Pig' for lunch
- Salamanca Orientation Tour - Known for its ornate sandstone architecture and for the Universidad de Salamanca

Day 5 Salamanca – Porto (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Gothic Church of St. Francis – View this most prominent Gothic monument in Porto.
- Porto Se Cathedral – It is one of Porto's oldest and most important local Romanesque monument
- Avenida dos Aliados – A sloping boulevard lined with grand buildings and a central promenade in the heart of the city
- Clerigos Tower – View the foremost undisputed landmark of Porto and a reference to the city's histories

Day 1 Singapore → Madrid (Meals on Board)
Assemble at Changi International Airport. Have a pleasant flight to Madrid

Day 2 Madrid (Dinner)

- Plaza Espana - One of Madrid's largest and most popular square
- Puerta del Sol - The gate was probably called after a sun drawn on it, hence the name 'Sun Gate'
- Gran Via - An ornate and upscale shopping street located in central Madrid
- Cibeles Fountain - Created in 1782, an emblematic and particularly beautiful fountain
- Royal Palace – Official residence of the Spanish Royal Family at the city of Madrid
- (Note: In the event of functions, the Royal Palace will be closed)



Day 6 Porto – Fatima – Lisbon (Breakfast/Dinner)
 • Shrine of Fatima – Visit the miraculous appearance of the Virgin Mary to three children in 1917

Day 7 Lisbon (Breakfast/Dinner)
 • Rossio Square - Pedro IV Square, has been one of the main squares in Lisbon
 • Sao Jorge Castle - A Moorish castle occupying a commanding hilltop overlooking the historic centre of the Portuguese city of Lisbon
 • Monuments of Discoveries - Built in honor of Henry the Navigator, instrumental in the success of the Portuguese explorations
 • Belem Tower - Constructed to guard Lisbon from seafaring raiders.
 • Jeronimo's Monastery - Grand religious building was historically associated with the early sailors as explorers, Vasco da Gama spent his last night before his voyage to the Far East

Day 8 Lisbon – Seville (Breakfast/Dinner)
 • Alcazar - Royal palace in Seville renowned as one of the most beautiful in Spain.
 • Jewish Quarter of Santa Cruz - Cobble streets, white-washed houses, cute shops in Jewish neighbourhood
 • Seville Cathedral – Visit to this build in 15th century, an expression in stone of Post-Reconquest confidence and wealth
 • Giralda Tower - The bell tower of the Seville Cathedral, originally built as a minaret during the Moorish period
 • Plaza Espana Seville – It was one of the main constructions and symbols of the Ibero-American Exposition World's Fair that took place in Seville in 1929

DAY 9 Seville – Ronda – Granada (Breakfast/Dinner)
 • Puente Nuevo - The newest and largest of three bridges that span the 120-metre-deep (390 ft) chasm that carries the Guadalquivir River and divides the city of Ronda, in southern Spain.
 • Plaza de Toros de Ronda - a Bullring in Ronda, it has a diameter of 66 metres (217 ft), surrounded by a passage formed by two rings of stone. There are two layers of seating, each with five raised rows and 136 pillars that make up 68 arches.

DAY 10 Granada – Valencia (Breakfast/Dinner)
 • La Alhambra – Visit this complete Arabic form palace and fortress complex located in Granada
 • El Generalife - A leisure place for the kings of Granada when they wanted to get away from the official affairs of the palace
 • Tower of Serrano and Cuarte - Two city gate towers are the most tangible remains of the ancient walled city
 • City of Art and Sciences - One of the largest scientific and cultural complexes in Europe

Day 11 Valencia - La Roca Village – Barcelona (Breakfast)
 • La Roca Village – Designer outlet over 130 fashion boutiques offers a luxury experience at great prices

Day 12 Barcelona (Free Day) (Breakfast)
 • Free Day

Day 13 Barcelona → Singapore (Breakfast/Meals on Board)
 • Sagrada Familia Church – Visit Famous unfinished Roman Catholic church in Barcelona
 • Montjuic Hill - A prominent hill overlooking the Barcelona harbour
 • Eixample District – A district most diverse in terms of shopping, restaurants and nightlife
 • Las Ramblas - One of the best-known tourist hotspots in Barcelona.
 • Plaza Catalonia - A large plaza surrounded by monumental buildings, is Barcelona's busiest square
